We know from the Bible more about Jeremiah than about any other of the biblical prophets. Jeremiah lived and ministered in what was a most tumultuous period in ancient Israel's history, a time when everything that was religiously treasured and revered, its temple, its sacrifices, its priesthood, and its status as a nation was being eroded and ultimately destroyed. It is possible to see our own tumultuous times reflected in The Book of Jeremiah, but then, we can also experience there Jeremiah's resolute faith that regardless of the circumstances our God is and continues to be the only secure foundation for true hope.
